Are you an Indigenous student looking for a stimulating and exciting internship for summer 2025? The Canadian Space Agency invites you to join us!

To build and maintain a more inclusive and innovative space sector, we need the creativity and ingenuity that stem from having a wider diversity of talents and perspectives. The Canadian Space Agency (CSA) is taking action towards reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples by taking meaningful steps to increase Indigenous voices at the CSA and within the Canadian space sector. As part of this effort, the CSA is launching this targeted recruitment campaign for the summer 2025 session.

Post-Secondary Co-op/Internship Program eligibility requirements:

- you must be a full-time student registered in a post-secondary co-op or internship program that is on our list of validated post-secondary academic institutions and programs (https://www5.psc-cfp.gc.ca/coop/noitcanoitutitsnimargorphcraes.do) *
 - this includes students with a visible or invisible disability, deemed to have full-time status by their academic institution, as well as people participating in adult education and retraining programs at the secondary level
- · your work term or internship must be an academic requirement, as determined by your academic institution
- · you must meet the minimum age required in the province or territory of work

Note: Preference will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents who meet the job requirements.

* Please note that if you are not studying in a program on the list of validated post-secondary institutions and programs, you can still apply through the FSWEP Ongoing Inventory (see more information via this link https://www.canada.ca/fr/commission-fonction-publique/emplois/services/recrutement/etudiants/programme-federal-experience-travail-etudiant.html). To ensure that we take into account all interested Indigenous students, we will also retain a certain number of students who have self-identified as Indigenous in their application to FSWEP. If you are already listed in the FSWEP directory, please ensure that your application is up to date and indicates an interest in one of the above locations.

Locations: Longueuil, QC / Ottawa, ON / Gatineau, QC* / Telework**

- * Please note that the Gatineau office will eventually move to Ottawa.
- ** Please also note that some student positions may require full-time or part-time on-site work, depending on the nature of the work involved. However, to respect Indigenous students for whom working from their community is essential to their identity, the CSA may authorize exemptions to allow them to complete the internship remotely. We encourage all students to apply.
